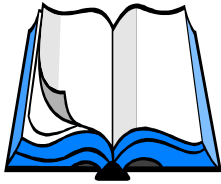

Bride – Family of God (ALL believers, not JUST Baptists) (The People of God)

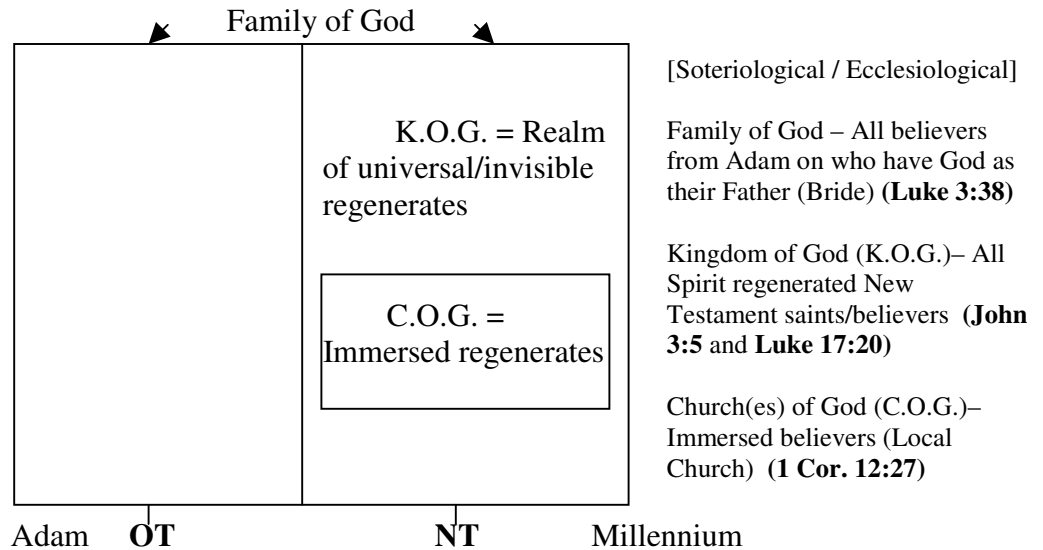

### *The Book of Psalms: A Treasure From God – (Part 7) – By: Craig G.*

**Psalm 16** – “Eternal life for one who trusts Him / Joy in His presence”

Vs. 1. – Trust in God and He will preserve thee.

Vs. 2a – Our soul knows that He is our Lord.

Vs. 2b – We are only good because of Him and His righteousness.

Vs. 3 – It is a delight to be with other saints (believers).

Vs. 4 – God 1<sup>st</sup>! No Other God...ONLY the Lord!

Vs. 5 – God is All in All and All we need. He keeps, provides and upholds us.

Vs. 6-7a – The Lord will instruct and guide me and I will praise Him for it.

Vs. 7b - Our bodies tell us of our Great Creator.

Vs. 8a – Set the Lord always before you.

Vs. 8b – He is always with us, thus we should not be moved (troubled).

Vs. 9 – Trusting God makes our heart glad and rejoicing in Him. My flesh will dwell securely (speaks of provision and healing).

Vs. 10 – He will save us from Hell.

Vs. 10b – The future King (Jesus) would not be hindered from defeating the wages of sin at the cross of Calvary!

Vs. 11a – He will show us the paths of life (Prov. 3:5-6) and in His presence is fullness of joy!

Vs. 11b – In His right hand are pleasures forevermore! Stay by His right hand. (i.e. Solomon)



## The Book of Psalms: A Treasure From God – (Part 7 cont.) – By: Craig G

### Psalm 17 – “Deliverance from the wicked”

Vs. 1 – Ask God to hear your prayer and your cause. Cry out to Him and pray with a pure/clean heart and a right spirit.

Vs. 2a – God will vindicate (defend, justify) us.

Vs. 2b – Keep your eyes on the things that are upright.

Vs. 3 – He will test and search us out. When He tests us, will He find evil (sin) unconfessed?

Vs. 3b – Do we purpose in our hearts that we might not sin against God?

Vs. 4 – Walk upright (godly) before others

Vs. 5 – God will uphold your

steps and keep you from falling when you walk with Him. Ask God for help.

Vs. 6 – Call upon God with a sound mind, a humble/contrite heart and He will hear us.

Vs. 7a – When we trust Him, He shows us His loving kindness and pleasures from His right hand (Ps. 16:11).

Vs. 7b – He will deliver us from all trials and persecutors.

Vs. 8a – His people (Israel/Believers in Christ) are the apple of God’s eye!

Vs. 8b – He will hide us under the shadow of His wings.

Vs. 9 – He will keep us from the oppression of the wicked.

Vs. 10 – The wicked have hard hearts and are filled with pride and hatred towards God and His people.

Vs. 11 – The wicked surround us and their eyes are only on evil. They worship sin and evil and set their eyes bowing down to earth.

Vs. 12 - They are eager to sin and are like a lion.

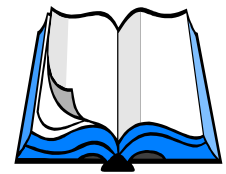
Vs. 13a – Ask God to confront the wicked of their sin and cast them down (break them).

Vs. 13b – He can deliver the wicked with the word. (Written = the Bible; Living = Christ)

Vs. 14a – Only God can deliver them (“with Thy hand”).

Vs. 15a – Seek God’s face in righteousness.

Vs. 15b – We shall be like Him (Jesus) someday and have a glorified body!



### II Timothy 3:16-17

*“All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.”*

## Wisdom From Proverbs – (Part 5) – By: Craig G.

### Proverbs 6

Vs. 1a – Do not be a surety (excepting responsibility for one’s debt if he/she fails to pay it) for a friend.

Vs. 1-2 – Don’t strike hands in a pledge with a stranger and be snared and taken by the words of your mouth

Vs. 3 – Choose your friends wisely! Are they believers? Do they know the Lord and love His word?

Vs. 4-5 – Get away from those who reject Christ and His word.

Vs. 6-8 – Consider the ant and it’s ways. Do not be a sluggard/lazy person. Slothfulness is most dangerous in the spiritual realm. As His servants, we need to be diligently serving the Lord with zeal and passion.

Vs. 9-11 – The results of laziness or the doom of the sluggard results in poverty and unmet needs!

Vs. 12-14 – The seven ways of a wicked, froward, ungodly, worthless, and most likely unregenerate man.

Vs. 15 – The punishment for the wicked man spoken of in verses 12-14.

Vs. 16-19 – Six things the Lord hates and seven that are abomination to Him: A proud /haughty look, a lying tongue, hands that physically harm others, wicked ungodly plans or thoughts, walking towards and enjoying sin and its pleasures, falsely accusing others, and sowing discord/gossip/causing strife among brethren.

Vs. 20-23 – Listen to your parents, pastors, and teachers as they teach you God’s word. Desire to apply the principles/teachings of God’s word to your life and walk with the Lord. See the positive results in vs. 22-23.

Vs. 24-29 – Avoid adultery! Strive to keep your mind and eyes from sensual lust(s).

Vs. 30-33 – Thievery and adultery contrasted. It’s consequences are no understanding and a destroyed soul!

Vs. 34-35 – The husband’s fury due to the adulterer, He’ll have no appeasement & no accepted recompense.

### Hebrews 4:12

*(Based on a series of sermons by Jim Schettler, former Pastor of the Campus Church at Pensacola Christian College)*

**THIS LESSON WILL BE BEST UNDERSTOOD WHILE DOING IT WITH YOUR PARENT(S) OR SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER AND HAVE THEM EXPLAIN EACH PARY TO YOU AND WORK TOGETHER ON IT WITH YOU.**

**Memory Verse: Psalm 34:9 “O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for *there is no want to them that fear him.*”**

### FAULTY FEARS OF GOD:

Read the passages and then match the faulty fear:

\_\_\_ *A Discouraging Fear*  
(Matt. 25:24-end; I Cor. 10:13; II Cor. 8:12)

\_\_\_ *A Defiant Fear*  
(Num. 14:1-end; Deut. 2:25; Exo. 23:27)

\_\_\_ *A Departing Fear*  
(Gen. 3:8-10; I Sam. 12:20-24; Exo. 20:18)

\_\_\_ *A Defective Fear*  
(II Kings 17:24-end)

**A:** Don't just teach people HOW to fear God. Teach them WHY to fear God? Because of who he is and what he can and will do in our lives. Don't say we fear God and then serve other gods! Do God's wants and desires, not ours.

**B:** People who think that God has been unfair to them and God is demanding more of them than they can handle.

**C:** Some sin is committed and they do not confess it. There is no sorrow about it and they try to hide from God.

**D:** Turning your back on God! Trouble in your life makes you angry at God and causes you to complain.

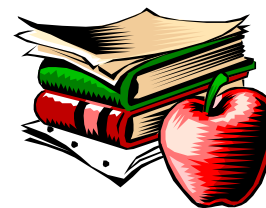
