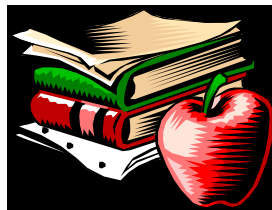

CHURCH PLANTING

Last month I introduced **Fort Kent, ME**. This town has about 4,000 population. There are only 5 or 6 churches in town, with none being Ind. Baptist. The town is made up of mostly Catholics with some J.W.'s. About 3/5 of the population speak both English and a French-Canadian dialect. Much of the population owns dual citizenship. The nearest town with a church of "like precious faith" is the city of Caribou, ME which is 55 min. away! There are also small towns along the US 1 corridor and in the Quebec province along the Saint John's River that would benefit from a church plant in Fort Kent. Please pray that the Lord would send someone to this needy community who is eloquent in both English and French-Canadian, that they could obtain dual-citizenship and plant a solid, local Bible-believing Baptist church here.
